Contributing Instructor Promotion Honorarium

A budget item is to be established each year for the funding of instructor promotion. This shall take the form of current year's dues being credited in January of each year to those members who:

- a. Are a current RCABC certified Lakewater Instructor,
- b. Significantly contributed to the immediate prior year's Basic Paddlers' lessons,
- c. Are approved by the Executive on the recommendation of the Training Director.
